Please note that 240 credit points are required to satisfy course completion requirements for ACU's National's Bachelor of Business or Bachelor of Information Systems which are usually undertaken full-time over three years. The above credit levels therefore represent one-sixth or one semester (40 cp) and one-third or one year (80 cp) of our normal Bachelor degree programs.

120 points are required to satisfy course completion requirements for ACU National's Master of Information Systems, Master of Management and Master of Business Administration which are usually undertaken full-time over one and a half years. The above credit levels into these courses therefore represent one-third or one semester (40 cp) of these Masters degree programs.

160 credit points are required to satisfy course completion requirements for ACU National's Master of Information Systems (Advanced) and Master of Business Administration (Advanced) which are usually undertaken full-time over two years. The above credit levels into these courses therefore represent one-quarter or one semester (40 cp) of these Masters degree programs.

Credit applications for partially completed courses and for other Kent Institute courses will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
